## The need for ARC coalition

India has a huge unmet need for contraception -- Over 44 million people (16.3 million for spacing and 25.5 million for limiting (DLHS -3). With a significantly large population in the reproductive age, affordability and easy availability of contraceptives is imperative.

Despite some progress, India's maternal and child health needs further improvement. Contraceptives save lives by preventing unwanted and risky pregnancies helping couples to plan and space children, resulting in better maternal and child health.
