Family Planning Directly Reduces the Number of Maternal Deaths because it Reduces the Chance of Pregnancy and Associated Complications



LOWERS RISK OF UNSAFE ABORTION



DELAYS FIRST PREGNANCY IN YOUNG WOMEN



REDUCES HAZARDS OF CLOSELY SPACED PREGNANCIES
