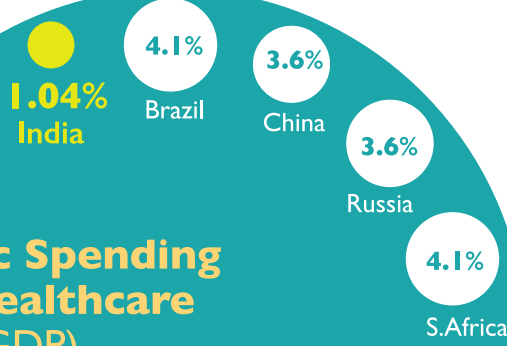

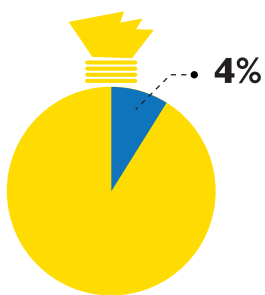

### Public Spending On Healthcare (% of GDP)

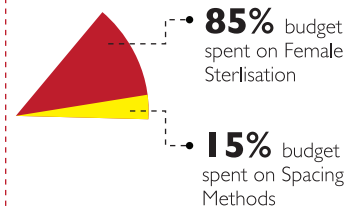
This compares poorly with other BRICS countries which have a higher spending on health by their governments
